Medical Excellence:

- More than 30,000 endoscopies performed, specialised as interventional endoscopist:
- OGD, Gastroscopy (e.g. hemostasis, stenting, mucosectomy, antireflux operation).
- Enteroscopy of small bowel, Video capsule investigation of small bowel.
- Colonoscopy, Proctology (mucosectomy, tumor ablation, haemorrhoid endotherapy, stenting).
- Endoscopic and percutaneous diagnostics therapy in the hepato-biliary and pancreatic duct system by means of ERCP, PTC and direct cholangioscopy.
- Endosonography of upper and lower GI-tract.
- Neurogastroenterology by means of pH-metry, manometry and impedance for functional investigation of oesophago-gastric and anorectal function.
- Breath test analysis with C13 and hydrogen to investigate for lactose intolerance, Fructose intolerance, bacterial overgrowth, Helicobacter pylori.

Scientific Work and Academic Teaching:

- 25 peer-reviewed paper in international medical journals such as Cancer, Gut, Endoscopy, Gastrointestinal Endoscopy.
- More than 200 presentations on congresses and scientific meetings.
- Academic teaching of students since 23 years in the field of gastroenterology, endoscopy, internal medicine, biochemistry and molecular biology.

Endoscopy Service now available in Al Ain Hospital:

- Upper gastrointestinal tract investigation and treatment with gastroscopy and OGD (Oesophago-gastro-duodenoscopy).
- Lower GI-tract diagnostics and therapy with Colonoscopy.
- Proctology for treatment of hemorrhoids and other anorectal pathologies.
- Biliary duct investigation and treatment with ERCP (Endoscopic retrograde cholangio-pancreatography).
- Pancreatic duct treatment with ERP (Endoscopic retrograde pancreatography).
- Advanced sedation techniques for painless and comfortable endoscopies.

Endoscopy Service expansion to state-of-the-art Endoscopy upcoming 2009:

- Introduction of state-of-the-art endoscopes for gastroscopy, enteroscopy of small bowel, colonoscopy and ERCP for the bilio-pancreatic duct.
- Minimal invasive treatment of the bile duct system by means of percutaneous transhepatic cholangiography (PTC) and direct cholangioscopy.
- CT-guided and Ultrasound-guided liver biopsy and liver abscess drainages.
- Telemetric video capsule for the investigation of the whole small bowel length of about 4-5 m.
- Neurogastroenterology with functional analysis of oesophago-gastric and anorectal motility (manometry), gastro-oesophageal reflux disease (impedance, pH-metry) and in addition wireless pH-metry of the oesophagus in order to identify and classify patients with reflux disease.
- Introduction of breath test analysis for Helicobacter pylori, lactose intolerance, fructose intolerance, bacterial overgrowth of small bowel and others.
- Summary: In the near future, Al Ain Hospital will have a top level and high performance Endoscopy Unit making it one of the most modern and best equipped Endoscopy Center worldwide and in middle east. A team of highly qualified and trained Endoscopists and Gastroenterologists will offer a state-of-the-art Service to the national community as well as to international patients.
